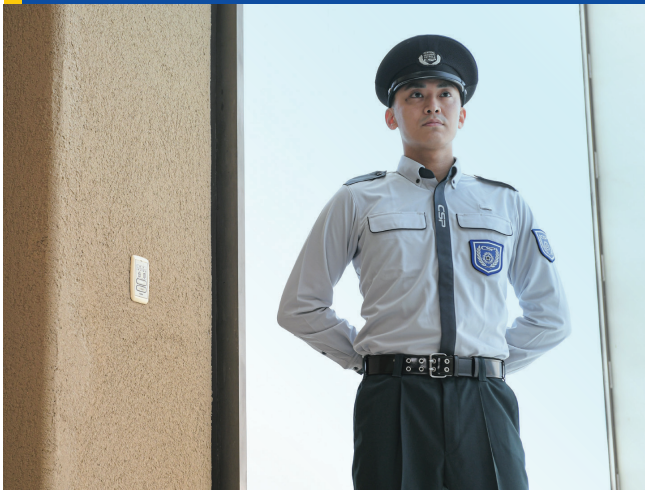

STATIONED SECURITY SERVICE



CSP guards commercial facilities, offices, and many other sites. We ensure safe, comfortable environments by controlling access, patrolling, and monitoring—even by assisting with visitor reception and guidance. Superior security, drawing on extensive expertise and experience as reinforced through rigorous training. Enhancements we are actively introducing include camera feeds surveillance and electronic security systems, enabling efficient stationed security service with the advantages of manned and electronic security approaches

ELECTRONIC SECURITY SERVICE



In case of the surveillance center receives alarm signals detected by various sensors installed at the customer's facility, Patrol officers will rush to the scene as necessary. High-quality security service for peace of mind and convenience, incorporating advanced technologies such as prepaid transportation IC card-based access control, camera feeds surveillance and analysis systems.

TRANSPORTATION SECURITY SERVICE



Safe, rapid, and reliable delivery of cash or valuables to designated sites at the appointed time and date, using secure transport vehicles equipped with new technologies and linked to the control center. Vehicle locations and a variety of other information is managed with GPS, with systems in place to ensure both security and environmentally conscious service.

SALES OF SECURITY AND SAFETY APPARATUSES



Comprehensive security and emergency product support, from sales to design, installation, and maintenance. The full range available includes sales and installation of security cameras, access control systems, and emergency equipment such as automatic fire alarm systems and AEDs. After-sales proposals also benefit customers, as by linking the equipment to online security systems.



Surveillance center services with camera feeds

Intruders, injured people, or suspicious objects in camera feeds are detected through remote patrolling or by image analysis systems. This service links on-site security cameras to a remote surveillance

center via a dedicated network to check camera feeds in real time, providing safety and security that is one step ahead.



Services for public facilities and businesses

CSP security experience and expertise is at work at many facilities and businesses where crowds of people come and go. In railway facilities, these services include special security and emergency attendant

notification at large terminals, rail yards, substations, and other critical areas spread around stations.

The full range of drone solutions available includes wide-area surveillance with tethered drones, inspection of narrow indoor spaces with small drones, pilot training, and counter-drone systems.

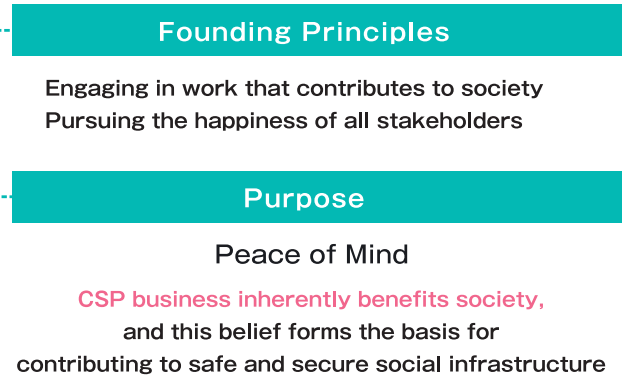
Sustainability

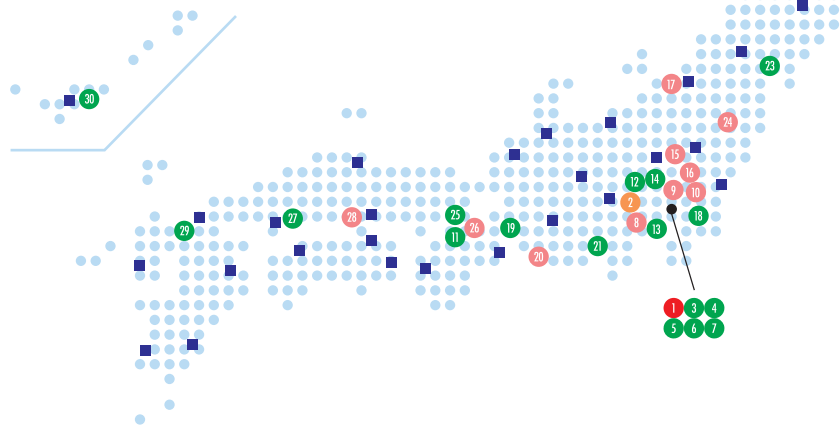


CSP Network
